# TRANSITION DAY

**Friday 4 May**

Your child will have the opportunity to visit our College and spend the day as a Year 7 student on Friday 4 May, 2018.

## Before Transition Day

- Complete and return the registration form, or visit Schoolbox online: [schoolbox.cmc.vic.edu.au](http://schoolbox.cmc.vic.edu.au). Login details are: username **guest** and password **guest** then click the **Transition Day icon**.

## Transport Arrangements

- Students from Bendigo Catholic Primary Schools, including St Monica's, St Liborius and Holy Rosary Heathcote, will be transported to and from school. Students will be picked up from and returned to their primary school.
- Students from St Mary's Castlemaine and Sacred Heart Elmore who wish catch the Country School Bus service to Coolock, are asked to register with Mrs Audra Petri, College Registrar, [apetri@cmc.vic.edu.au](mailto:apetri@cmc.vic.edu.au).

## What to Bring

- A cut lunch or a lunch order and money in a paper bag labelled with the child's order, name, school and amount enclosed. It would be of great assistance if this is done before arrival. Visit Schoolbox, [schoolbox.cmc.vic.edu.au](http://schoolbox.cmc.vic.edu.au) using the username **guest** and password **guest** then click the **Canteen icon** to view the menu.
- A notebook, pens and pencils.
- It is recommended that your child wear their current school's Physical Education (PE) uniform, particularly suitable footwear for PE. (Participation in a PE class depends on which class a child is placed in for the day.)

## Timetable

- Arrive at Catherine McAuley College, Coolock Campus, Mclvor Highway, Junortoun. Assemble in **McAuley Square**.
- Short welcome from the Principal. Children divided into groups to be part of a **Year 7 Housegroup**.
- Lunch orders collected.
- Each group will be taken to the place where school bags can be stored and then to class.
- The visiting students will be participating in a normal day's timetable with their host classes. This will enable them to gain an overview of the workings of Catherine McAuley College.
- Visiting students will assemble in **McAuley Square** for goodbyes and dismissal at 2.30pm. (Castlemaine and Elmore students and those using the country bus network will be dismissed at 3.30).
- Student will be issued an Enrolment Pack including an application for enrolment.

## Special Arrangements

- If your child has an aide please arrange for him/her to attend with your child.
- If your child has anaphylaxis, diabetes or any other medical condition that requires particular attention, please ensure that he/she brings the necessary medication and action plans. Catherine McAuley College staff do not administer medication on Transition Day, so please make arrangements with your child's primary school.
