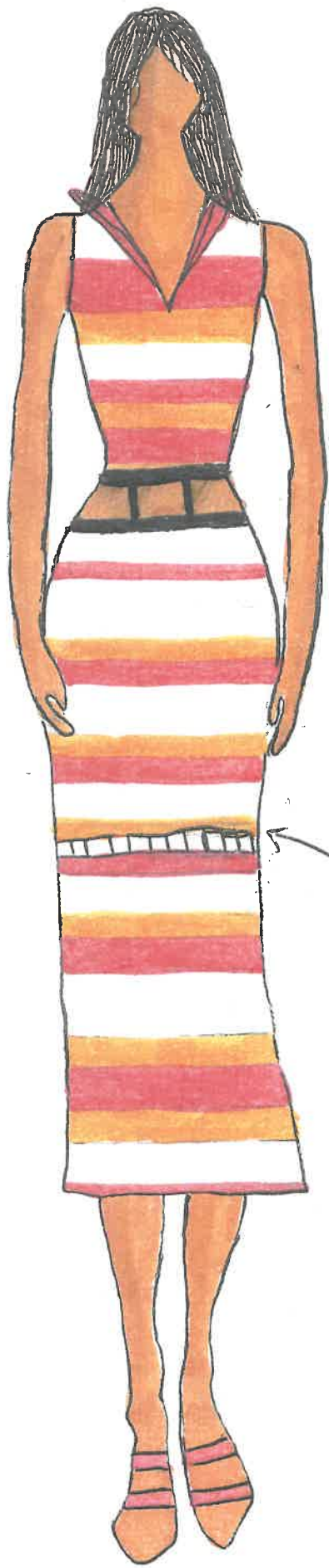

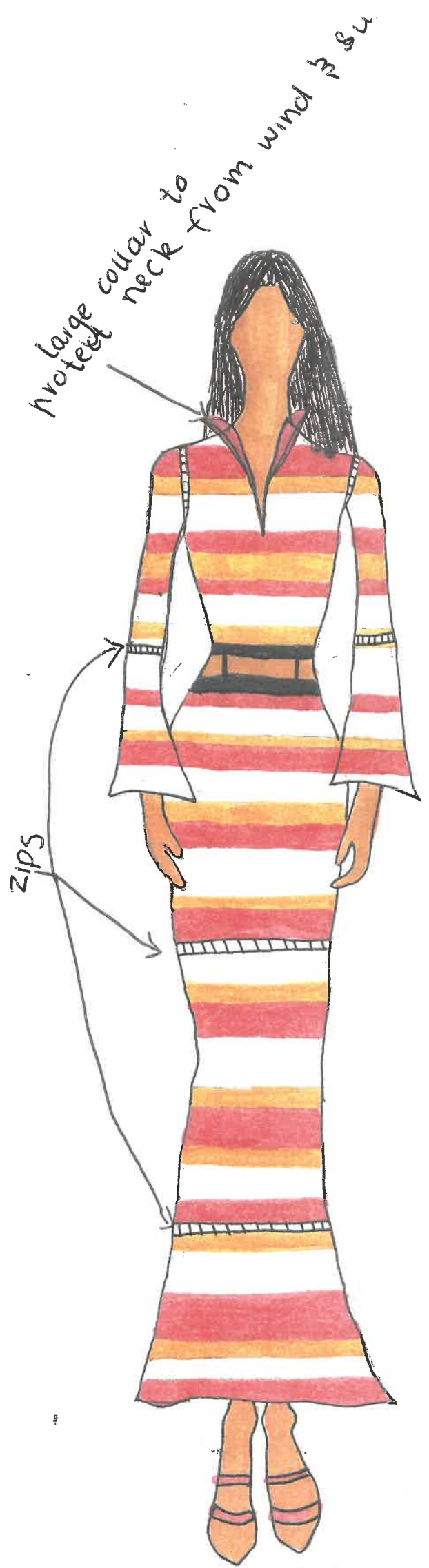

Large collar to protect neck from wind & sun

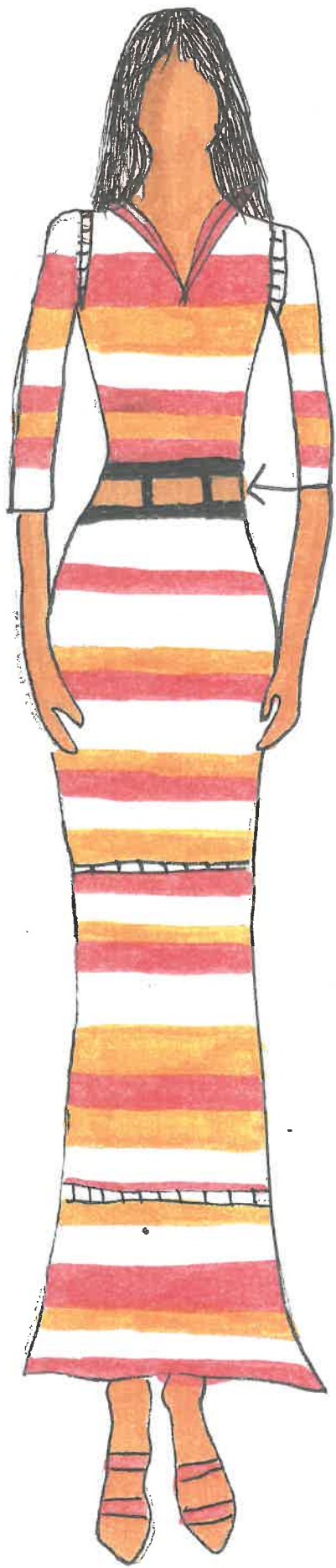

'Multifunctional Dress'

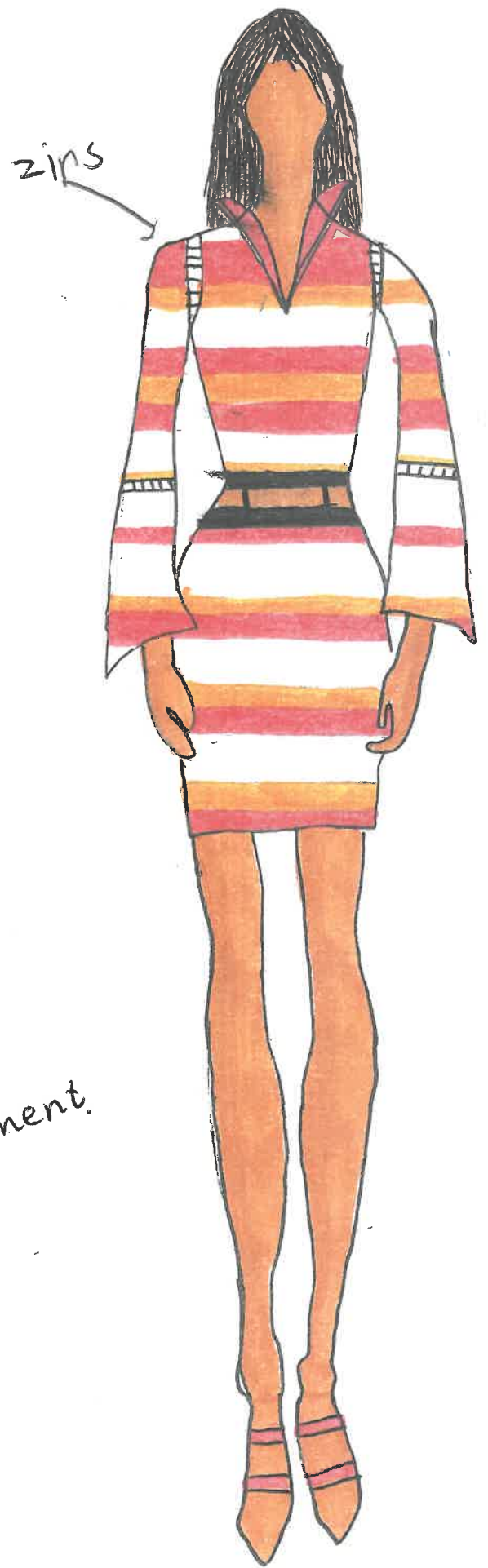

Fabric To Be Worn:

I have chosen worsted-spun-fine knit to be used as the fabric on my garment. I believe this is a good material/fabric for a design like this as it 'hugs' your body which is the way my design is.
