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Dear Parents and Carers

As you will be aware, the VCE Unit 3&4 examination period is fast approaching. The results from these examinations make a significant contribution to students' final study scores and consequently their ATAR score. As your child continues the remainder of term 3, they will complete their final SACs and will prepare for examinations.

To support students with this preparation, the College has several holiday support sessions, in the form of summary lectures and practice examinations. We strongly encourage students to attend these sessions, as they can inform how students best use their final few weeks of study to prepare for these exams. A copy of the holiday revision timetable is attached.

Research has shown that while exams can be stressful to many students, the support that teachers and parents provide to students at this time makes a significant difference to reducing anxiety and to outcomes. To continue our support of students through the final weeks of their study, the College asks that during Term 4, all year 12 students remain at school on Friday afternoons until at least 3.25pm to complete practice examinations. These exams will run in exam conditions and will be supervised by college leadership members. The purpose of these exams is to get students familiar with the examination environment and conditions, prior to the actual exams, and to better support students in their revision process. These practice exams will run in the Kelly building on Friday afternoons from 1.50pm. Students may choose to stay as late as 5.00pm to complete longer practice exams, such as the 3-hour English exam.
