### Scholarship Snapshot

<b>Overview</b>	The Scholarship aims to assist academically outstanding but disadvantaged students, <b>from a rural or regional area</b> , who have been offered a full-time place at an Australian university or college for the first time.
<b>Faculty</b>	All
<b>Study area</b>	All
<b>Scholarship type</b>	Need based, Merit based
<b>Year of study</b>	First year undergraduate bachelor's degree
<b>Duration</b>	One year initially but may be awarded for up to two years (dependent upon academic performance)
<b>Intention of Scholarship</b>	Accommodation costs and/or other expenses directly related to the study of successful applicants (eg. course costs, study related materials/equipment, text books, tutoring)
<b>Award Value (per student)</b>	Award values remain at the discretion of the special Committee. Award value is \$5,000 (per annum) based on previous years
<b>Eligibility</b>	To be eligible, the following criteria must be met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Australian citizen or permanent resident <b>from a rural or regional location</b></li><li>• first year undergraduate in 2020 (first attendance at an Australian university)</li><li>• studying full-time in 2020 (in an approved Australian course)</li><li>• graduated from secondary school in either 2019 or in 2018 (taken a gap year)</li><li>• demonstration of the disadvantage (economic and/or social) hindering further study</li><li>• outstanding academic achievement and community involvement</li></ul>
<b>Nationality</b>	Australian citizen or permanent resident
<b>Applications open</b>	2 December 2019
<b>Applications close</b>	28 January 2020

<b>Criteria</b>	Scholarships will be awarded on the recommendation of a selection committee and will be assessed on academic achievement, demonstrated disadvantage and community contribution.
