

Agricultural Scholarship

In 2020, The Rotary Club of Bendigo will award a scholarship to support a student taking a tertiary course in Agriculture. The scholarship will provide the successful student with funding to the value of \$2,000 per year for up to two years (subject to academic performance) to assist with their tertiary studies. The funding is to support study-related expenses including course costs, study materials and equipment, textbooks or tutoring.

The successful student will:

- Be a first-time undergraduate tertiary student in 2020;
- Have completed secondary school in Bendigo during 2019;
- Show sound academic achievement and community involvement;
- Have been offered a place at to study agriculture at University or a post-secondary agricultural college**;
- Demonstrate an understanding of agricultural industries;
- Have a career commitment that will ultimately benefit agriculture and/or regional and rural communities;
- Be an Australian citizen or permanent-resident.

Selection process

Expressions of interest will be called for in October 2019.

Reporting

The successful applicant will be expected to make a short presentation to a Club meeting on the award of the scholarship and on the completion of first year studies.
