Year 9 Transition and End-of-Year Program 2022

Monday 31 October and **Wednesday 2 November**: Year 10 Year Level Leaders, Ms Kate Watts and Mr Colin Hogan, will visit Year 9 classes to introduce themselves, provide information about St Mary's and to answer any questions students may have.

Wednesday 9 November: An additional transition visit to St Mary's for a small group of students, including the English Language Assistance Program (ELAP).

Students will conclude their Year 9 program at Coolock on **Friday 18 November**. The morning will involve a campus assembly and then Student Advocate time as part of a Formation Day. BBQ lunch provided.

In the afternoon, students will then travel by bus to the St Mary's Campus (Barkly St, Bendigo) for a tour, locker allocation for Headstart and a welcome assembly. Students will be dismissed from the St Mary's Campus.

Lockers

Students are required to empty their lockers at Coolock by **Thursday 17 November 2022**. This can be a gradual process over the course of the week to avoid heavy bags on Thursday. Students will only need laptops for Friday 18 November - no books. After this date, lockers will be cleared. Students are to keep their lock for use on their St Mary's locker during Headstart.

Headstart 2022 at St Mary's

Headstart: Monday 21 November until Friday 2 December | St Mary's Campus

Headstart provides students with the opportunity to begin their Year 10 program and familiarise themselves with their subjects and environment. Individual timetables will be emailed to every student prior to the commencement of Headstart.

Headstart is compulsory and involves full classes for all current Years 9, 10 and 11 students.

Full College summer uniform (including hat) is to be worn during Headstart.
