 - Assisting with Advertising
- Assist with organising and encouraging participation whole Campus events including:
 - Caritas K's
 - Mercy Day
- Promoting recognition of achievements in sports and events

 - Use of water, energy and other resources

 - Providing student feedback on campus needs
- Assist with organising and encouraging participation in Environmentally focused days

Faith, Social Justice and Inclusion Captain (SRC): 2 per Year Level

 - Liturgies
 - Daily Prayer
 - Prayer tables
- Assist with organising and encouraging participation in Campus events with a Social Justice focus including:
 - Caritas K's
 - Mercy Day
 - Rug Up Day
 - Harmony Day
- Raise awareness of specific social justice and inclusion issues, and significant days, for various local and global communities
- Contribute to an inclusive education community by raising awareness and developing initiative for specific issues within the student body
