



Urban Bus Passes 2023

FOR URBAN BUS TRAVELLERS TO COOLOCK CAMPUS, JUNORTOWN
(Approved Country Bus Travellers do not need to purchase a Bus Pass)

STEP 1

Obtain a Student Concession
Application Form
(available from mid-January)

- Obtain a Student Travel Concession Application* from Catherine McAuley College website www.cmc.vic.edu.au, Bendigo Railway Station, Bendigo PTV Hub at Bendigo Marketplace or online at www.ptv.vic.gov.au. Available from mid January.
 - It is not compulsory to buy a Bus Pass - students can pay as they go on **myki**.
- * Please note: if your child has a Catherine McAuley College Student ID Card, with a PTV logo, you are not required to obtain an Urban Bus Pass ID but you need to renew at the above locations by 28 February each year.

STEP 2

Complete Application Form and
attach 2 passport-sized photos

- Complete all sections of the form except for Section H.
- Affix two passport-sized colour photos. (Grade 6 photos or school photos are acceptable.)

STEP 3

Authenticate Application Form
from 16 January 2023 and
purchase a PTV School
Student ID Card for \$9

Obtain PTV School ID/Pass

Visit the General Office at Coolock or St Mary's to have form authenticated by College staff, then go to the PTV Hub at Marketplace or Bendigo Station to purchase the Student ID/Pass at a cost of \$9.00.

STEP 4

Purchase your
myki Bus Pass

Attend the PTV Hub at Bendigo Marketplace or the Bendigo Station with your Travel Concession Card, or completed paperwork stamped by the College, to obtain your MYKI/bus pass.

- Full-year and half-yearly myki/bus passes are available.
- PTV staff recommend that you register your card, either when you purchase your myki/bus pass, online at www.ptv.vic.gov.au or phone 1800 800 007.

Conveyance Allowance

If you live more than 4.8 km from the campus your student is attending, you may be eligible for Conveyance Allowance. Allowance only available to urban bus travellers and a receipt for the bus pass must accompany the conveyance application. Bus Bays
