Year 9 Transition and End-of-Year Program 2023 **Tuesday 14 November:** An additional transition visit to St Mary's for a small group of students, including the English Language Assistance Program (ELAP).

Friday 17 November: Students will conclude their Year 9 program at Coolock. Families will receive more information about this Formation Day.

Lockers

Students are required to empty their lockers at Coolock by **Thursday 16 November 2023.** This can be a gradual process over the course of the week to avoid heavy bags on Thursday.

Students will only need laptops for Friday 17 November - no books. After this date, lockers will be cleared. Students are to keep their lock for use on their St Mary's locker during Headstart.

Headstart 2023 at St Mary's Headstart: Monday 20 November until Friday 1 December | St Mary's Campus

Headstart provides students with the opportunity to begin their Year 10 program and familiarise themselves with their subjects and environment. Individual timetables will be emailed to every student prior to the commencement of Headstart.

Headstart is compulsory and involves full classes for all current Years 9, 10 and 11 students.

Full College summer uniform (including hat) is to be worn during Headstart. Families of Year 9 students requiring temporary travel for the purpose of the CMC Headstart Program are required to submit a paper-based Ad Hoc Travel Form.
