

# **Uniform Update**

"Families and the College working together always builds stronger partnerships."

In Terms 2 and 3, the College transitions to the winter academic uniform for all students, with exceptions granted on days designated for specialist or co-curricular activities where the sport uniform is approved.

To ensure clarity, we've summarised key aspects of the uniform expectations below:

- All students are required to wear their blazer to and from the College. Additionally, all students are to wear their blazer to Student Advocate Group.
- Students must wear the College tie and appropriate leather lace-up shoes with academic uniform, rather than sports shoes.

We are dedicated to supporting you in ensuring your child's compliance with the correct uniform each day. Should there be any concerns regarding your child's adherence to our Uniform Policy, their Student Advocate will reach out to you.

Rest assured, we are committed to upholding this College expectation and eagerly anticipate collaborating with you to continue to instil strong values across the College.

## **ACADEMIC UNIFORM**

**ACADEMIC SCHOOL SHOES:** black leather lace up shoes or buckle T-bar leather shoes.

**BLAZERS:** the blazer is compulsory and must be worn in Terms 2 and 3 and any other special occasion when requested.

## **SPORT UNIFORM**

**SOFTSHELL JACKETS:** the sport softshell jacket is only to be worn with sport uniform. (Students can wear either their jumper or blazer with academic uniform if they are cold.)



Students at Coolock and St Mary's are allowed to wear their uniform within the following guidelines. Academic uniform is to be worn at all other times.

#### **YEARS 7 & 8**

- Physical Education (practical classes only)
- Sports training

#### YEAR 9

- Physical Education (practical classes only)
- Agriculture (double period only)
- Leadership in Sport (double period only)
- Active for Life (double period only)
- Outdoor Education (only those classes that require it)

## YEAR 10

- Physical Education (one practical double a week)
- Permitted VET or VCE subjects

## VCE/VET UNITS 1 - 4

- Physical Education (one practical double a week)
- VET Agriculture
- VET Animal Studies
- VET Sport and Recreation (one practical double a week)

## STUDENTS WHO ARE OUT OF UNIFORM

We understand that there may be circumstances beyond a family's control that may affect adherence to these expectations. Any student who is not in full College uniform should have written permission from their parent or carer and will receive an approved uniform pass.

Students who are out of uniform without written permission will be followed up through our <u>Student Code of Conduct</u> and <u>Uniform</u> policies (you will need to log in to <u>PAM</u> to read these). Students will be provided with three reminders before the uniform process is escalated to written communication with families.

Should the issue continue, parents/carers will be requested to attend a meeting to develop supports to ensure the correct wearing of the College uniform.
